On Course

Ladies

Allowed

Short socks including those below the ankle.
Tailored Skirts, trousers or shorts.

Collared shirts with or without sleeves.
Round or turtle neck shirts.
Shirts tucked into skirts, shorts etc. but may be outside if designed to be worn this way.

Shirts front to be on or above collar bone.

Men

Allowed

Knee high or short socks including those below the ankle.

Short socks should be plain and mainly white.

Tailored trousers or shorts.

Collared shirts with sleeves.
Round or turtle neck shirts.
Shirts tucked into trousers and shorts but may be outside if designed to be worn this way.

Not Allowed

Socks rolled down.
Mini skirts or mini shorts.
Cargo pants or shorts.
Stirrup pants.
Pull on or draw string shorts/slacks.
Sun tops or Tee shirts.
Prominent logos.
Bare midriffs

Track suits.
Denim or beach wear.
Hats worn backwards.

Not allowed

Socks rolled down.

Cargo pants or shorts.
Pull on or drawstring shorts/slacks.
Trousers tucked into socks.
Tee shirts.
Prominent logos.

Track suits.
Denim or beach wear.
Hats worn backwards.
Overalls or work jeans.

All golfers should wear properly designed golf shoes on the course, preferably with soft spikes.

All golf clothing listed above.
Smart casual attire.

Not allowed

Golf Shoes.
Hats
Denim clothing
Sports trainers or track suits
